

What Should I Bring to Camp?



Put your name on **EVERYTHING!**

Check off when packed... **DO NOT bring anything valuable**

- Bible & notebook with pen/pencil
- Towel, washcloth
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Toiletries, soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
 - Container to carry toiletries, soap, shampoo to showers
- Sleeping bag or bedding
- Pillow
- Sunscreen, chap stick/lip balm
- Flashlight (with fresh batteries)
- Camera (with necessary accessories)
- Spending money for gift shop (optional)
- Prescription Medication: will be given to the nurse upon arrival
- Clothing Guidelines:
 - Layers! It gets cold (and wet)!
 - Hats/gloves
 - Modest swimwear
 - NO sagging shorts or bare midriffs (girls)
 - Athletic shoes -CLOSED toe (mandatory for activities)
 - Hiking Boots (optional)
- Modest swimwear (for Polar Bear Plunge)
 - Separate pool towel
- Flip flops /sandals for pool and shower
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Raincoat (disposable work well)
